

CBI to investigate Trading Scam Cases

- State Cabinet has decided to hand over cases registered at various Police Stations in Assam related to the matters of Unregulated Deposits involving fraudulent transactions and trading of huge amounts of money in unregulated manner to Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI)
- Cabinet has also directed Home and Finance Departments to jointly draft a Standard Operating Procedure (SoP) to prevent occurrence of such activities in the future

DASSAULT to enter Assam

- To impart domain specific skills to Engineering and Science students in Assam and to upskill employees, Cabinet has approved the proposal to establish a Centre of Excellence (COE) in Aerospace & Defence, Automotive & Electric Vehicle Industries etc.
- Dassault Systèmes India Pvt Ltd will be investing ₹200cr along with external monitoring, advisory and implementation support, for this CoE
- ▶ This initiative will train 3,000 engineering graduates in Robotics, Aerospace, Defence, Al and more.







Huge step to reduce Case Pendency

- To allow courts to continue to devote time for serious offences and decongest jails by releasing the Under Trial Prisoners who are accused in petty cases, Cabinet has accorded approval to amendment of Para 3 of Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) issued vide Notification No. E-217405 dated 21.10.2022 for withdrawal of petty/minor criminal cases in subordinate Courts throughout the State
- ▶ Under this policy, approx. 81,000 petty and minor cases have been withdrawn till March 2024

Special Teacher Recruitment

- Cabinet has accorded approval to Amendment of the Assam Secondary Education (Government Schools) (4th Amendment) Service Rules, 2024 and the Assam Secondary Education (Provincialised Schools) (4th Amendment) Service Rules, 2024
- This will facilitate the holding of a Special Recruitment Drive and provide an opportunity to 4,669 Additional (Contractual) Teachers working under the Scheme "Strengthen and improve the quality of Secondary Education in the State of Assam"
- This decision will help utilize the vast experience of the Additional Contractual teachers, mitigate shortage of teachers in Secondary Schools and lead to improvement in the quality of education







KEY DECISIONS

Coming Up: State-of-the-Art-Sports Stadium in Kokrajhar

- To enhance sports Infrastructure in the BTR region, Cabinet has accorded Administrative Approval to Construction of a State-of-the-Art Sports Stadium in Kokrajhar at a cost of ₹107.89cr
- The Stadium will be replete with modern facilities like:
 - 13,500-seater Football stadium
 - 8-lane synthetic running track (400m length)
 - An Olympic standard aquatic centre with seating capacity for 750 spectators
 - 1,200-seater Indoor Stadium
 - A multi-purpose field for training for sports such as football, cricket, hockey, volleyball etc., 4 lawn tennis courts and 2 boxing rings

Powering up the Future through Clean Energy

- To boost power availability in the State, Cabinet has accorded approval to procurement of 100 MW of Wind Solar Hybrid Power from NTPC by APDCL
- This procurement will help in meeting the shortfall in power supply during the evening and night peak hours in Assam

Coming Up: New Flyover in Down Town Junction, Ghy

- To facilitate smooth traffic management on the busy Mahapurush Srimanta Sankardev Road (GS Road), Cabinet has accorded approval to Construction of Flyover at Existing traffic signal near Downtown Hospital under SOPD 2024-25 at a cost of ₹111.654cr
- ▶ The project components include Flyover and approaches with RE Walls, service roads, drainage, development of parking area, restoration & road safety works, etc.









Upgradation of Assam State Zoo cum Botanical Garden, Ghy

- To upgrade facilities and experience at Guwahati Zoo at par with international standards, Cabinet has accorded Administrative Approval to Modernization of Assam State Zoo cum Botanical Garden, Guwahati at a cost of ₹362,04,12,933
- ▶ This modernisation will provide improved living conditions and enhanced medical and quarantine facilities for the wildlife residents and boost tourist footfall in the Zoo

Boosting Entrepreneurship with Chief Minister Atmanirbhar Asom Abhijan (CMAAA)

- ▶ The Governing Body of CMAAA in its first meeting approved 25,238 beneficiaries under the Chief Minister Atmanirbhar Asom Abhijan including 174 professional candidates and 25.064 general category candidates
- After completion of 3-day mandatory training, professional beneficiaries will receive ₹2.5 lakh and general category beneficiaries will receive ₹1 lakh in the first tranche
