## (IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES)

In continuation to Advertisement No. SLRC-G-III/91/Advertisement/2023/2 and subsequent notices, the following instructions are hereby published for information of the candidates for the written examinations under the State Level Recruitment Commission for Class-III posts scheduled to be held on 29-09-2024. Candidates are requested to go through these instructions carefully in addition to the instructions given in the Admit Card.

- Before starting to answer on the OMR Answer sheet, candidate must ensure that the OMR Answer sheet belongs to him/her on the basis of Roll number mentioned on the OMR Answer sheet.
- Candidates are advised to verify the location of the Examination Venue a day in advance so that they do not face any problem on the day of Examination. All candidates are directed to report at least one and half hours before commencement of Examination for thorough checking and frisking.
- 3. No candidate shall be permitted to enter the examination centre after the gate closing time i.e. the examination start time. No candidate shall be permitted to enter the examination centre without Admit Card, valid ID proof and proper frisking. Frisking will be carried out by police and/or by authorized personnel manually as well as through metal detector. If any candidate is subjected to improper frisking, the candidate shall immediately report to the Centre-incharge.
- For speedy frisking, it is advisable that candidates wear half-sleeve attire and wear slippers instead of shoes.
- Candidate will be permitted to carry only the following items with them into the Examination Venue:
  - Admit Card downloaded from the SEBA website (a clear print out on A4 size paper).
  - Valid Identity Proof (in physical form), preferably Identity proof issued by Government – like Aadhaar card /PAN Card/ Driving Licence/Voter ID etc.
  - Blue/black ball-point pen, Plastic cards like credit/debit cards and minimum cash.
  - iv. PwBD certificates and scribe related documents, if any.
  - Transparent personal water bottle without labels, but the same has to be handled very carefully.
- 6. Candidates will be allowed to take away their Question Booklets after the examination. After the examination is over, OMR Answer sheet will be first collected by the invigilator. The candidate shall remain seated in the examination hall for additional 5 minutes. Once the invigilator has verified receipt of OMR Answer sheets and is satisfied, candidates will be allowed to take away their Question Booklets and leave the examination hall.
